

Burn Suspension Lifted

The City of Alturas Fire Department is announcing the end of the burn suspension on November 29, 2018 at 6:00 am for the Alturas City Limits. Burn permits will still be required. You Can Purchase one for \$10.00 at Alturas City Hall.

WARNING

The permit issued does not relieve the user of any legal responsibility for the safe use of fire or allow burning to be done in violation of any State, Local or Federal laws and regulations restricting the use of fire.

Permittee may be held liable for suppression costs for any fire that escapes your control regardless of what caused it to escape. The Fire Department is entitled to reimbursement for the public funds which were expended.

Don't forget the following proper burning techniques:

Never leave the fire unattended

*Burning Hours are from 6:00 am to 12:00 pm. All burning piles CAN NOT be bigger than 4 ft by 4ft and it has to be dead out by noon (12:00p.m.). **DO NOT** let fire smolder*

Make sure you have proper clearance cut around the pile and have a shovel and water on sight so that you can quickly put out any fire that may escape from the burn pile.

DO NOT burn garbage in your incinerator or on the ground.

DO NOT burn any combustible materials upon or in any street, sidewalk, parkway or alley.

DO NOT burn Grass or weeds that have not been cut without an inspection.

DO NOT burn on windy days.

Be considerate of your neighbors and where the smoke from your burning piles may drift.

*Burn Barrels Are **NOT** allowed in the city limits*
